Superior of South Indian Province, priests, religious, parishioners and civic officials from the Government of Meghalaya. In the afternoon, Eucharistic Adoration was organised to thank God for His blessings on the parish for the last 50 years. An entertainment programme, which included the felicitation of people who were part of the Golden journey of the parish, added joy to the celebration.

Good Shepherd Parish Jongksha was bifurcated from the Cathedral Parish,

Laitumkhrah. Shillong, in 1972. It initially was administered by the Salesians of Don Bosco. In 1976 the parish was handed over to the Congregation of Holy Cross, and Fr.



Isaac Kelamparambil, CSC, was appointed as the Parish Priest and Fr. Joseph Kuzhikkat, CSC, as Assistant Priest. In 1985, the Good Shepherd Parish was bifurcated and gave birth to Holy Cross Parish, Mawkynrew, also administered by Holy Cross.

Over the fifty Golden Years, Good Shepherd Parish has grown to a population of 14,618 spread across 21





villages. Apart from the pastoral needs of the parish, Holy Cross Fathers are also engaged in meeting the



educational needs of the people. Parish runs twentythree schools up to 5th grade and seven

schools up to 8th grade. It also runs two secondary and one senior secondary school, catering to about 3700 students.

It was a truly rejuvenating and hope-instilling experience for the entire membership. There was a



tangible manifestation of fraternal concern, ministerial affirmation, and spiritual

solidarity in all the reports, sharing, and reflections during the annual assembly.

The membership is genuinely grateful to our Provincial Fr. Simon Fernandis, CSC, and the provincial administration for

organising a full-day session on the 06th of January on a very relevant and vital topic, "Social Media and Ethics" by Fr. (Dr.) Shiju Edassery, CSC, Director



Peyton Institute Bangalore. The session was very scientific, informative, and enlightening. He warned us that the misuse or inappropriate use of social media would cause us much harm and damage, such as loss of personal reputation, loss of money and time, loss of privacy, and loss of self-confidence. It will have far-reaching consequences on public life, mission, church, and the province as we represent them. Therefore, sufficient knowledge, awareness, and prudent and productive use of social media must be taken seriously as it is essential for our contemporary life and ministry.



especially with easy access to advanced social media.

The community retreat that followed the annual provincial assembly was yet another unique experience for all who attended it. Fr Luke Rodrigues, SJ, a Mumbai Province Jesuit, animated the retreat passionately and spiritually on the topic of Ecology with an explicit focus on integrating the mystery of creation into our spirituality. His primary reference was the reflection and wisdom of His Holiness Pope Francis articulated in 'Laudato Si' and the Holy Bible. The cosmic walk, exercise on the
